1 For Economic Stability and Accountability

Labour have borrowed over £167m - £3m in debt repayments each year which cannot be spent on the services that Exeter needs.

2 For Better Refuse and Recycling

- ✓ We will encourage the planting of wildflowers and spring bulbs.
- ✓ We will find resources to keep Exeter's byways clean and tidy.

4 For affordable homes and sensible planning

Purpose Built Student flats (off campus) pay neither Council Tax or Business Rates although they still expect Exeter to provide services - this is wrong. Exeter Labour has a poor record of delivering social housing for families or single people to meet demand.

- ✓ We will encourage local communities to develop

Neighbourhood Plans so they help determine what is built.

- ✓ We will prioritise building social and affordable housing for rent and sale on brownfield sites.
- ✓ We will charge developers for pre-planning advice encouraging development that is needed in Exeter.

5 For our City Centre

Exeter needs a City Centre that is vibrant, safe, exciting, clean and inviting. The current provision for coaches is inadequate – visitors are not welcomed, just dumped in a side road. Many say that Exeter is becoming too expensive to visit

- ✓ We have a vision for a modern Exeter that acknowledges and respects its history.
- ✓ We will improve CCTV, street cleaning and re-introduce street wardens.

- ✓ We will freeze car park charges for 2 years. We will seek to introduce free parking for 30 minutes and free parking on at least some Sundays in each month.

6 For reaching Net Carbon Zero by 2030

Labour declared a Climate Emergency Exeter but has no plan that will achieve Net Zero by 2030. We will put the environment centre stage.

- ✓ We will work to secure more land for allotments.

- ✓ We will provide new electric charging points as should developers.
- ✓ We will work with business to put a robust plan for Net Zero in place.
