Survey results - August 2020

Introduction

In July and August we conducted two online surveys to find out what local residents wanted to see in the new Wonford Health and Well-Being Hub. One was with the general public, and the other with pupils from two local secondary schools, Isca Academy and St Peter's.

- General survey: 341 households, 980 residents (80% Wonford residents)
- Schools survey: 80 responses
- Surveys for young people and people with disabilities is still ongoing.



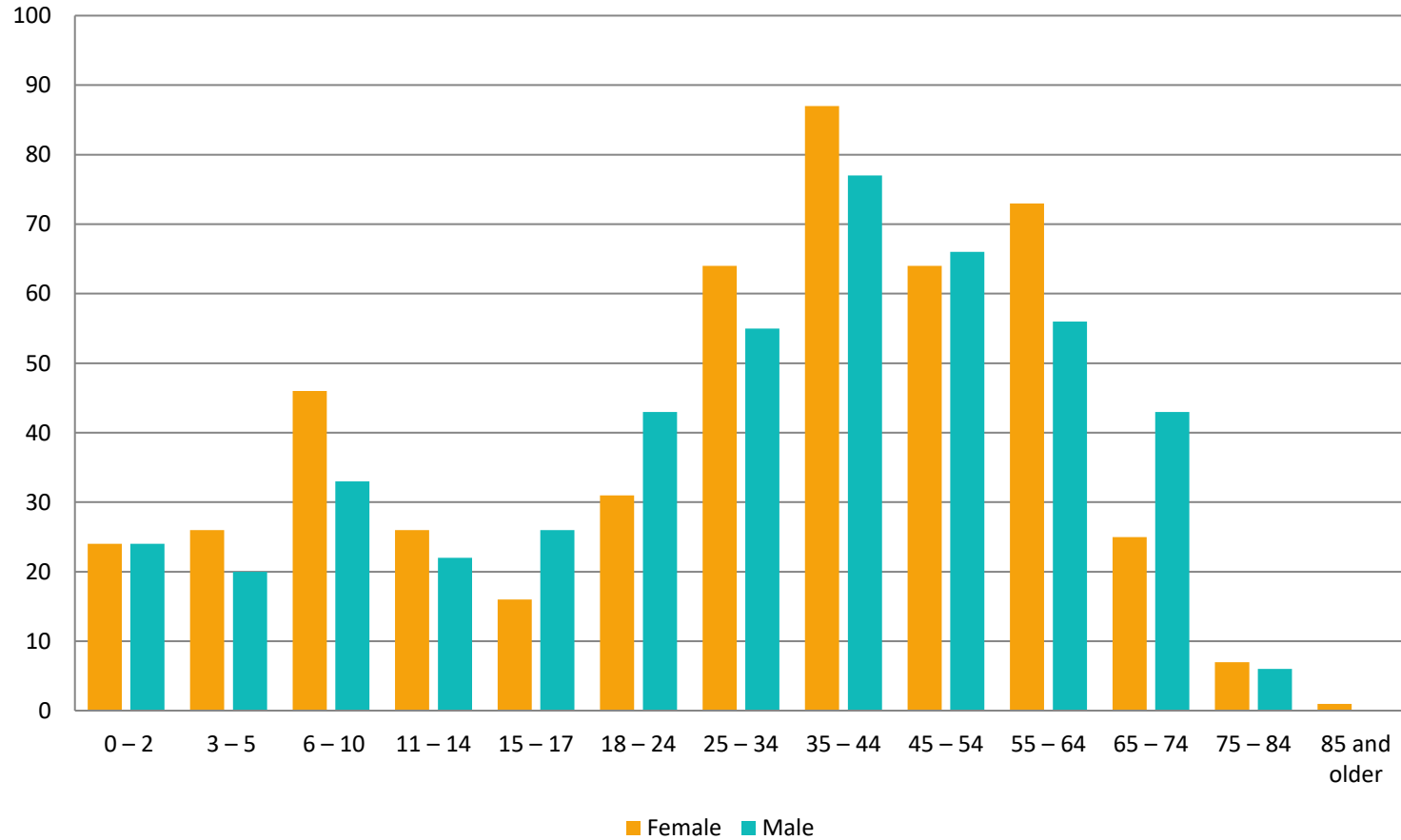
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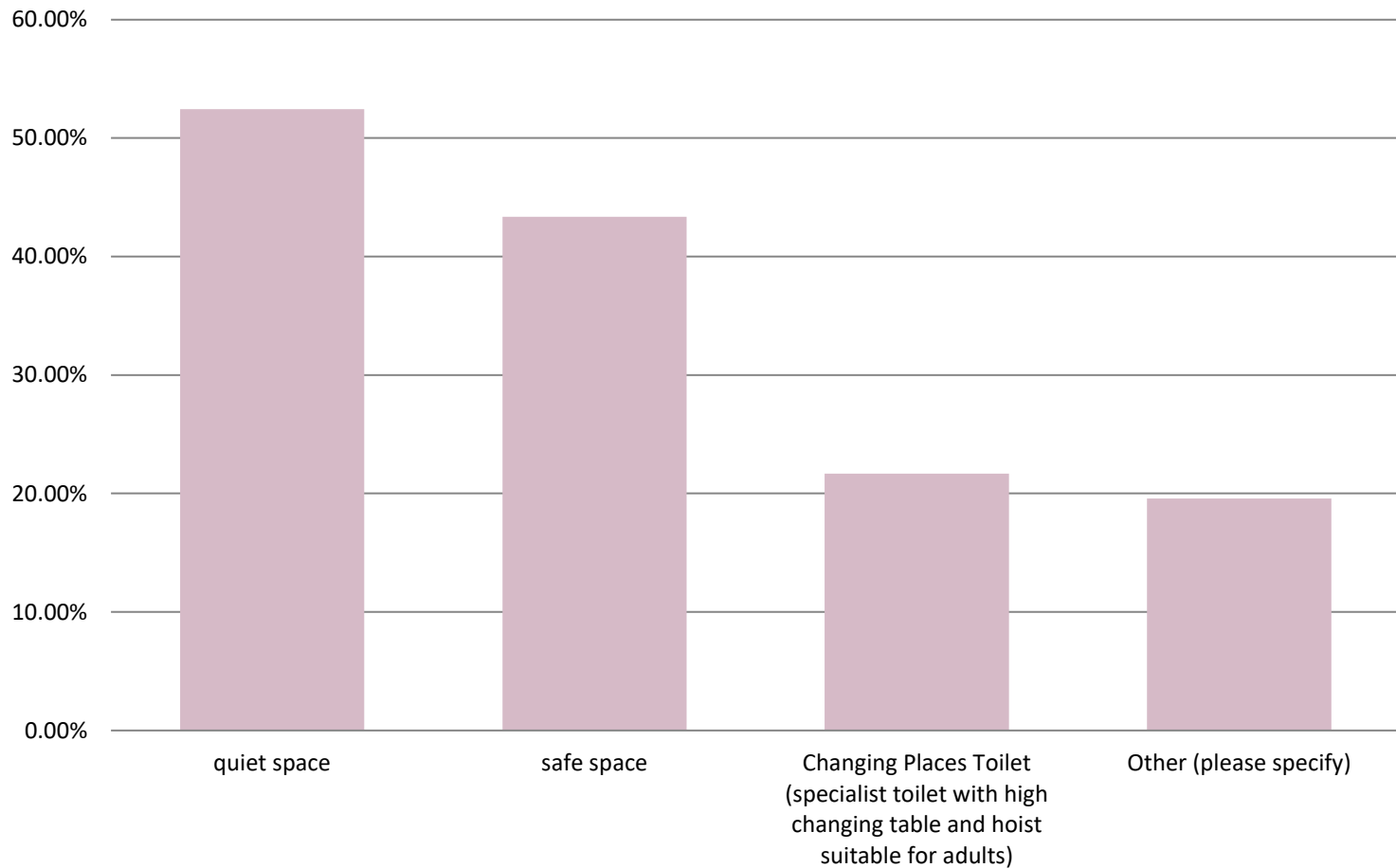
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Very excited at the prospect of a new community hub with modern ideas and some activities which have been lost over time. Like the lunch club and dances!

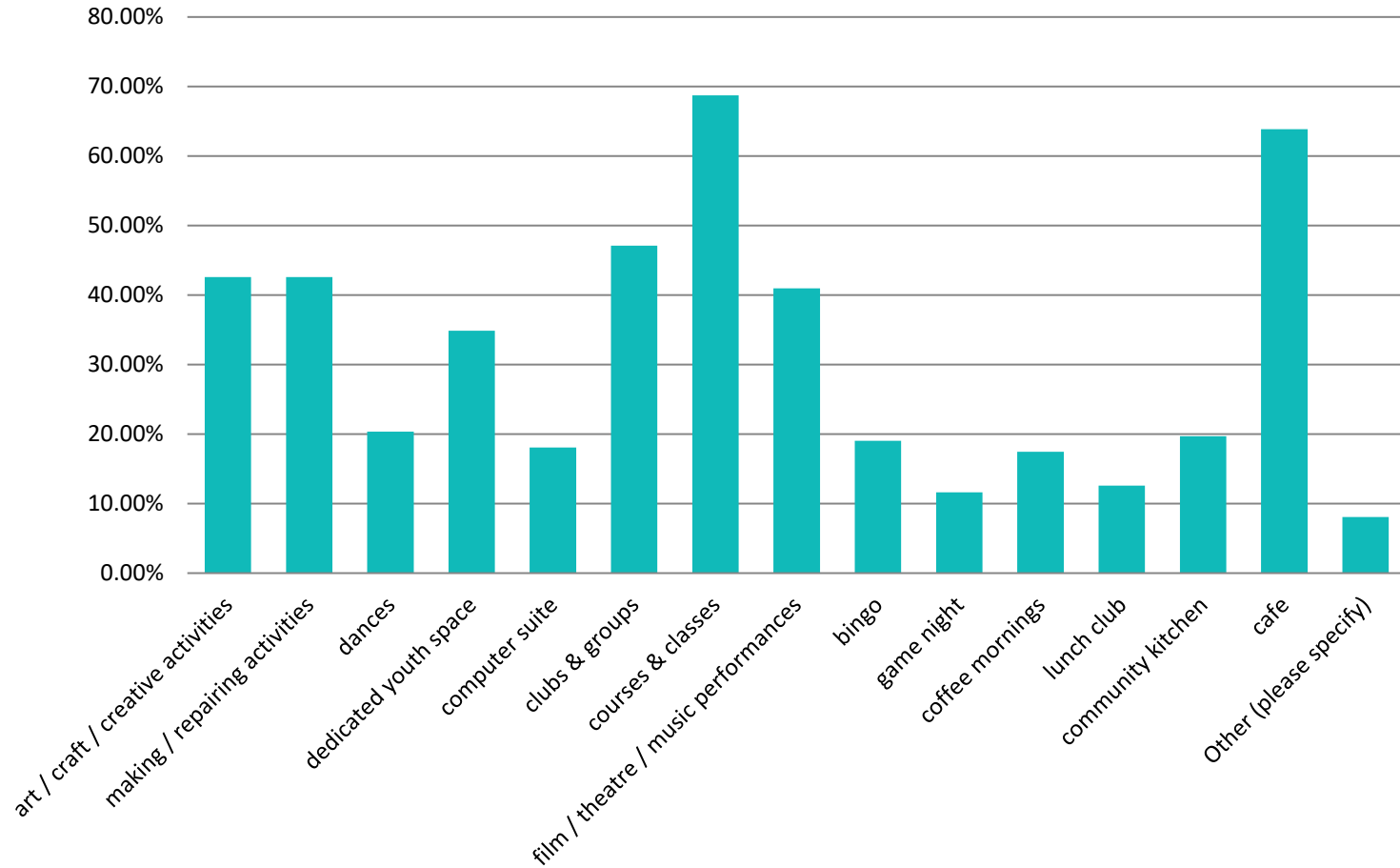
Total Wonford survey respondents (residents) by **age** **and gender**

What 7 **social activities and facilities** you or your household would like to use in the new HWB Hub? (n=310)





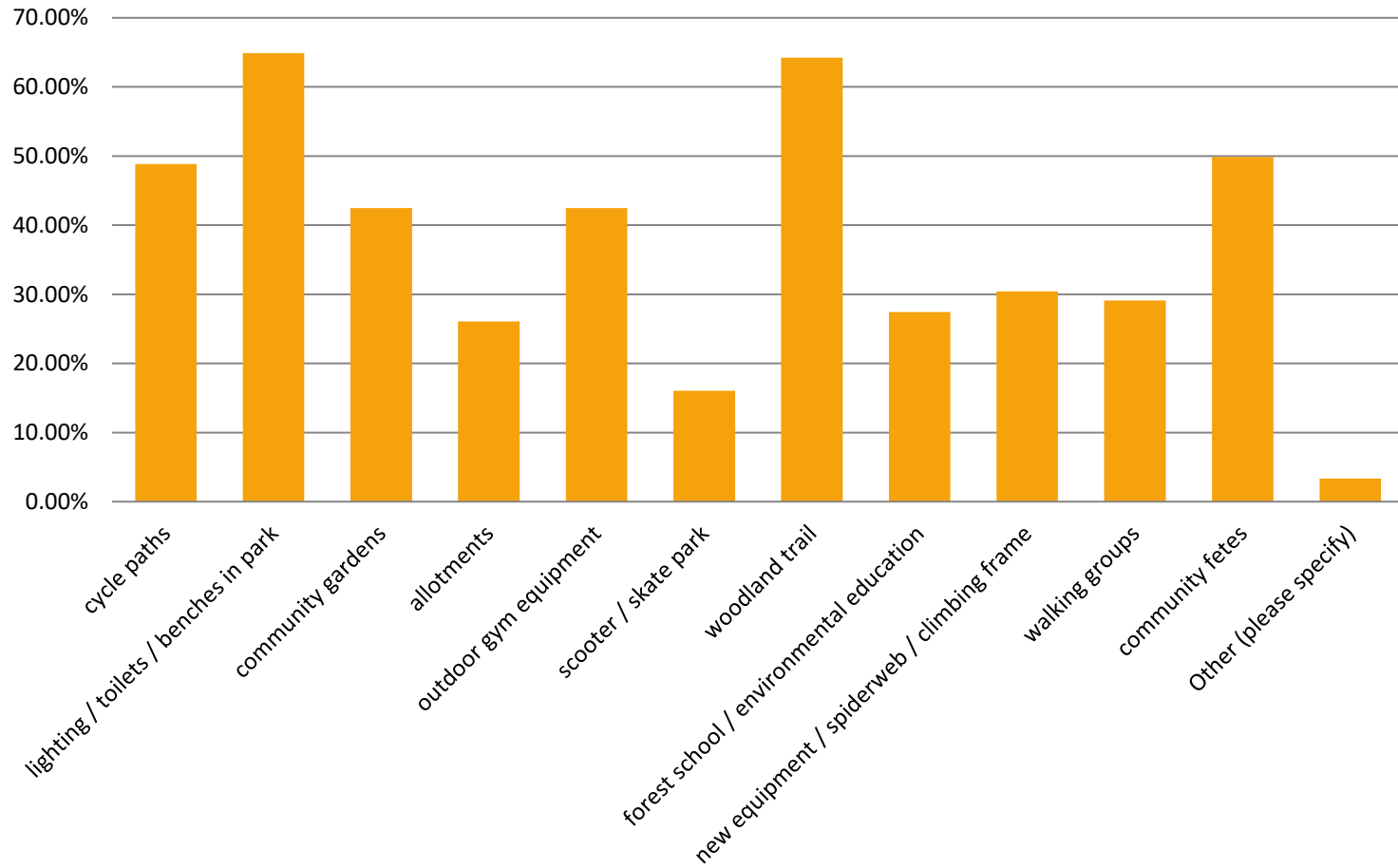

What **6 outdoor spaces, activities & facilities** would you or your household like to use in the new HWB Hub and green spaces? (n=299)

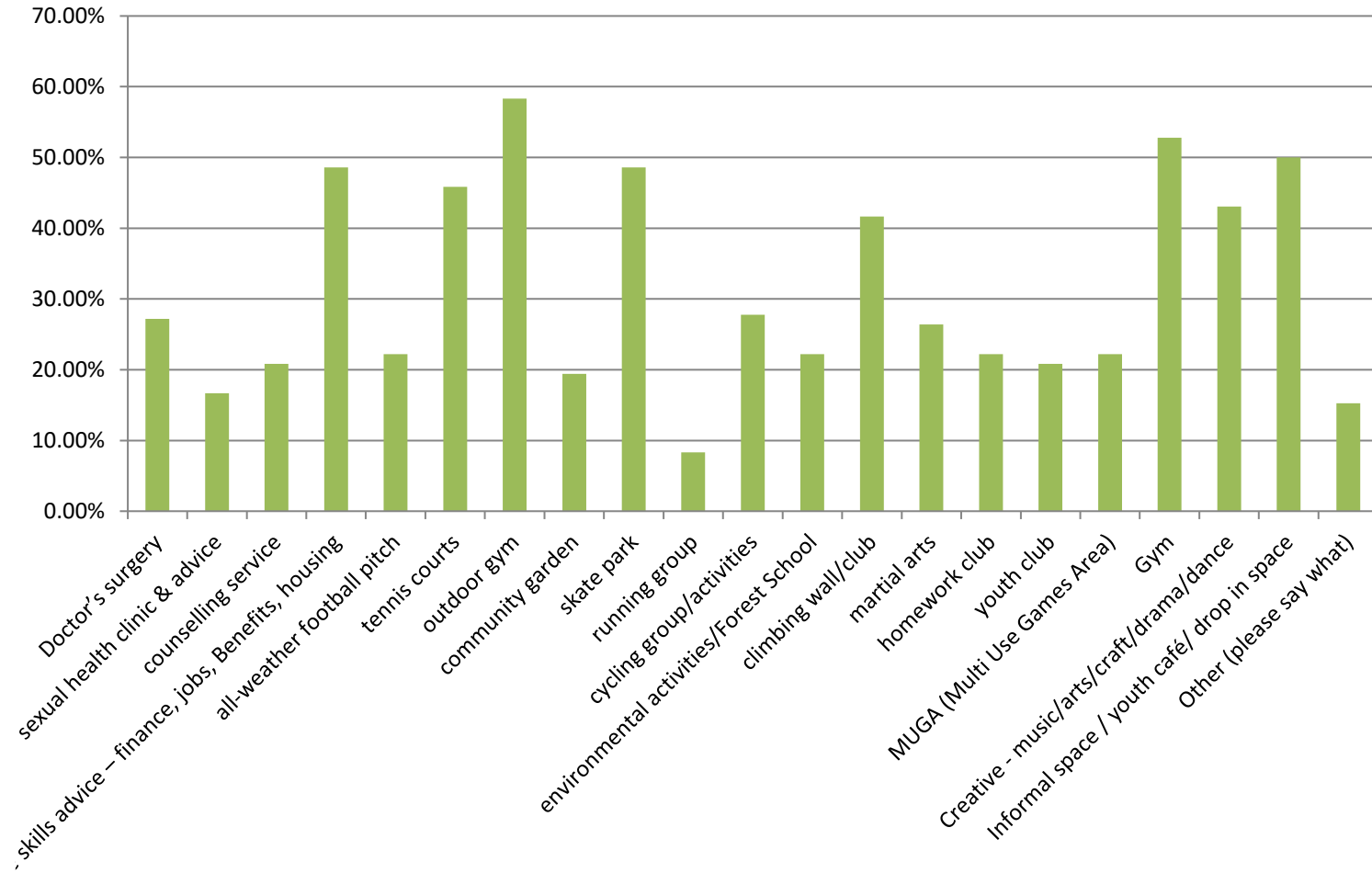


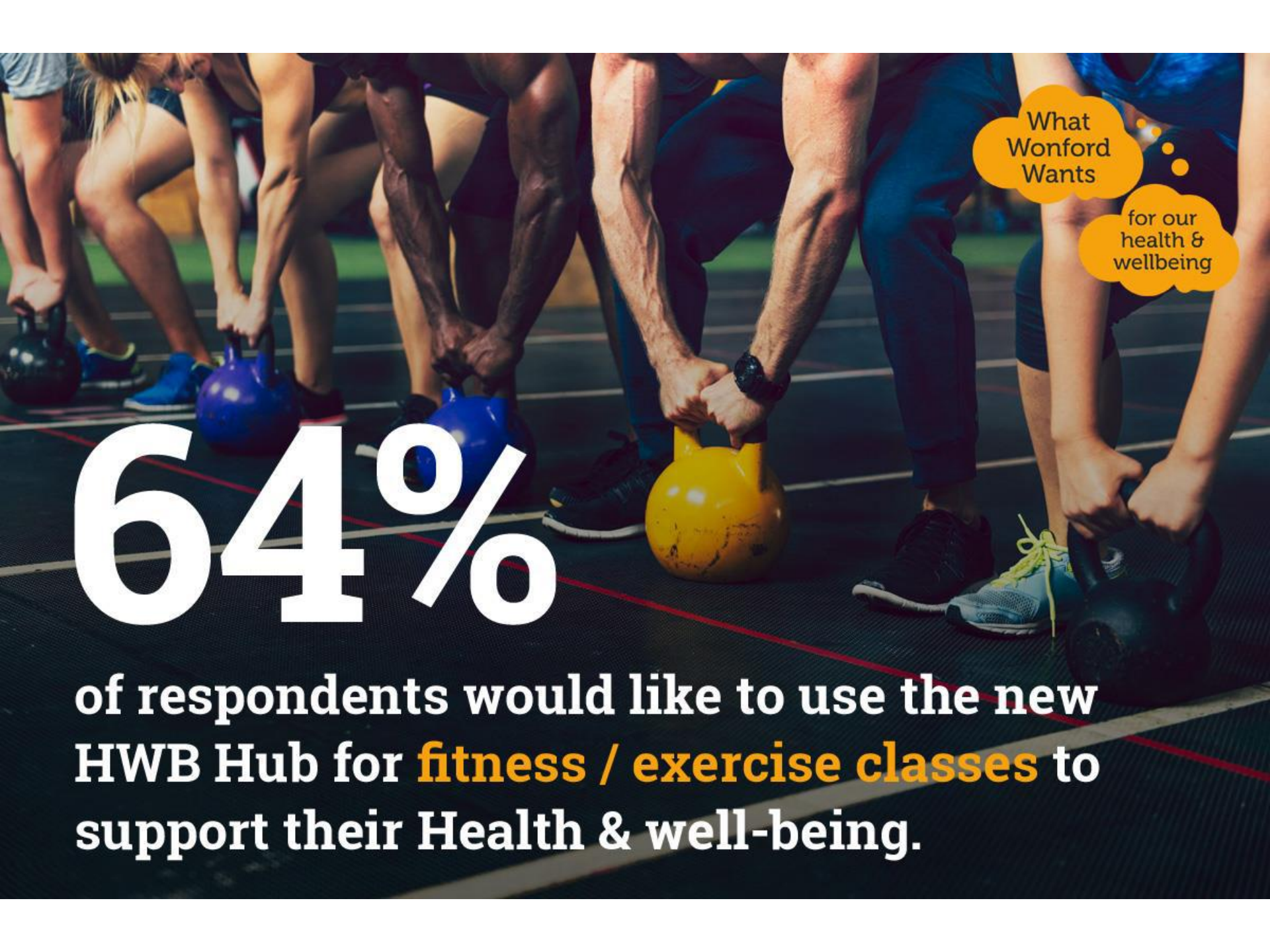

What 10 things you'd like to have in a new Wonford Health and Well-Being Hub? (Young people n=72)





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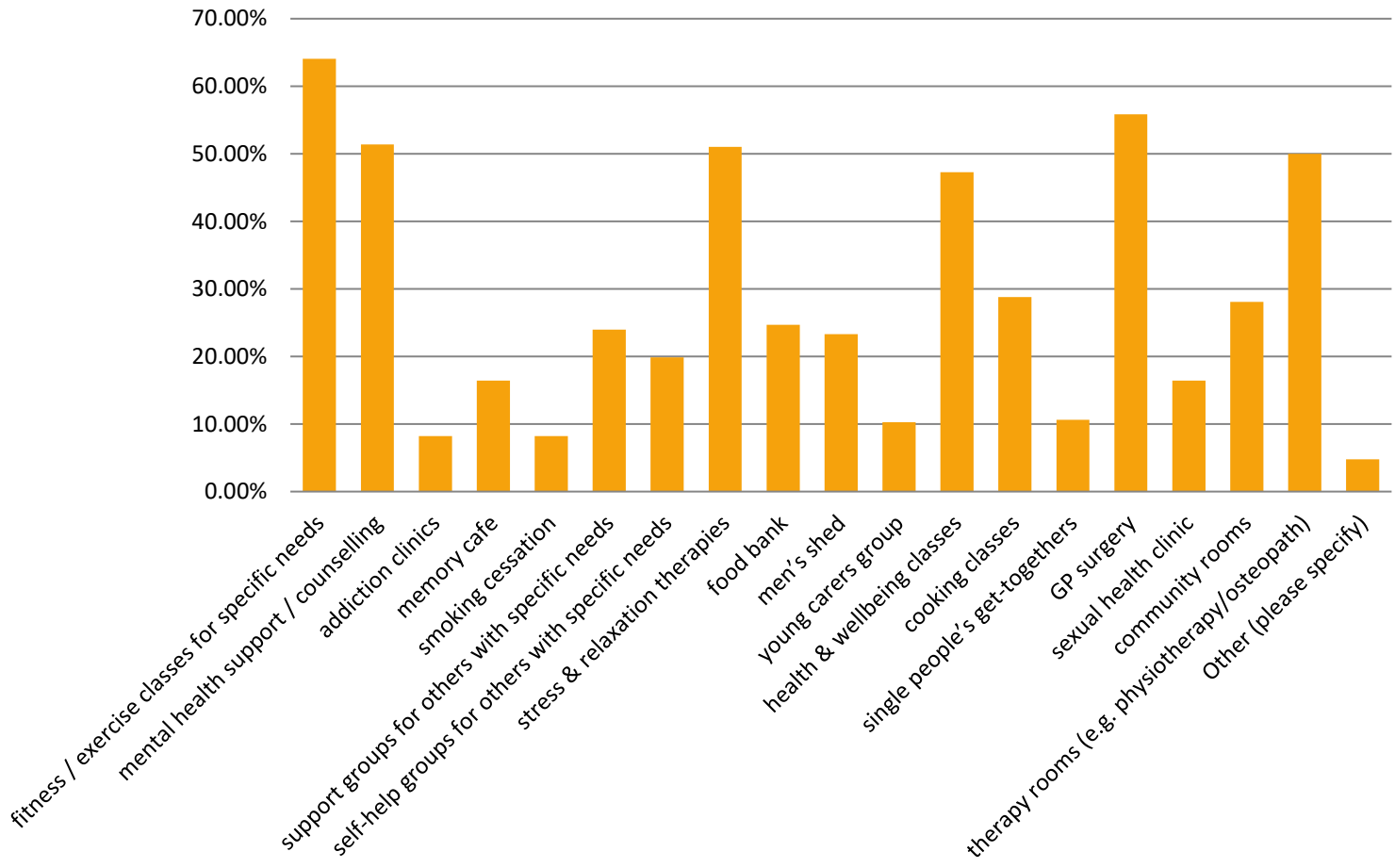

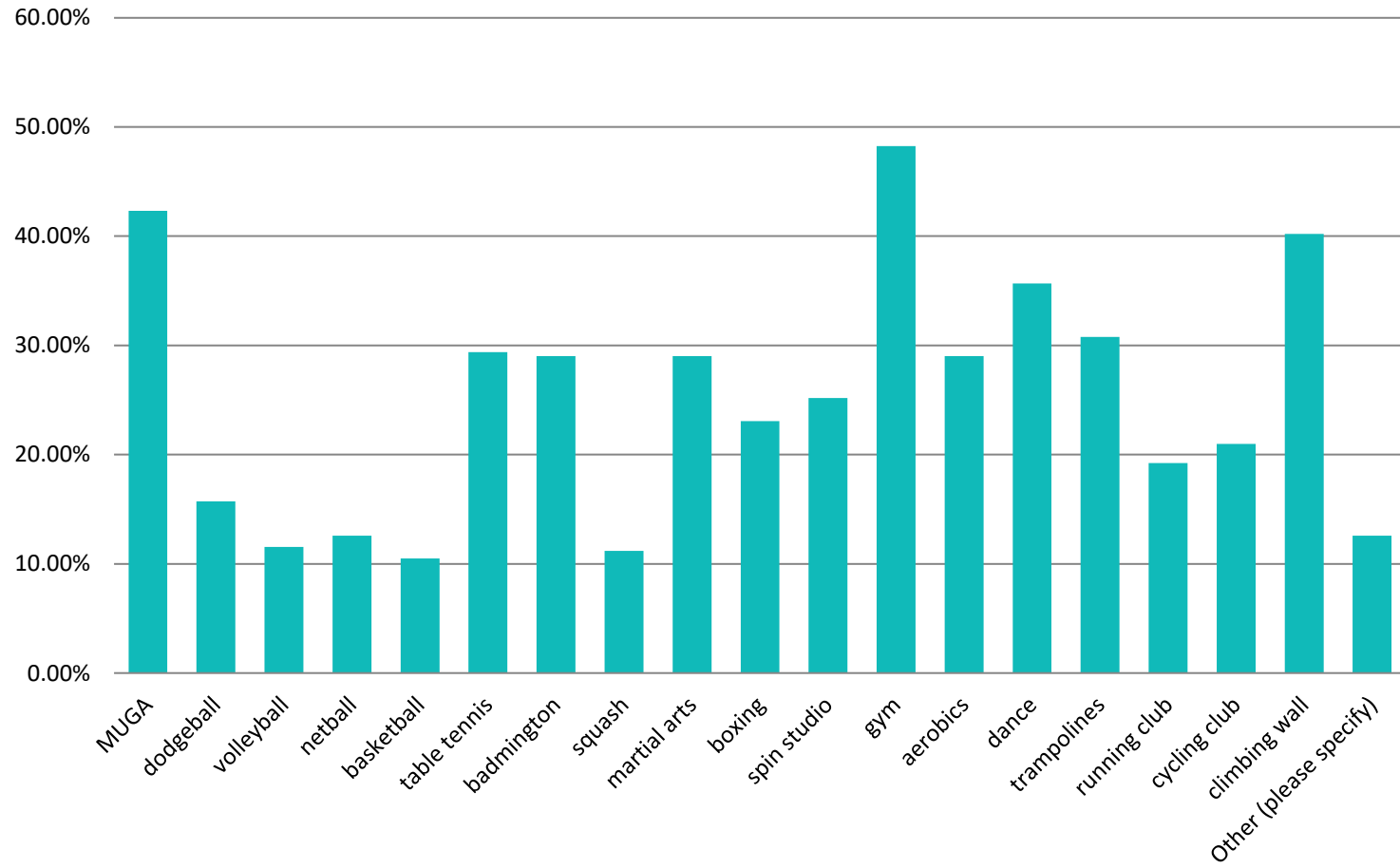

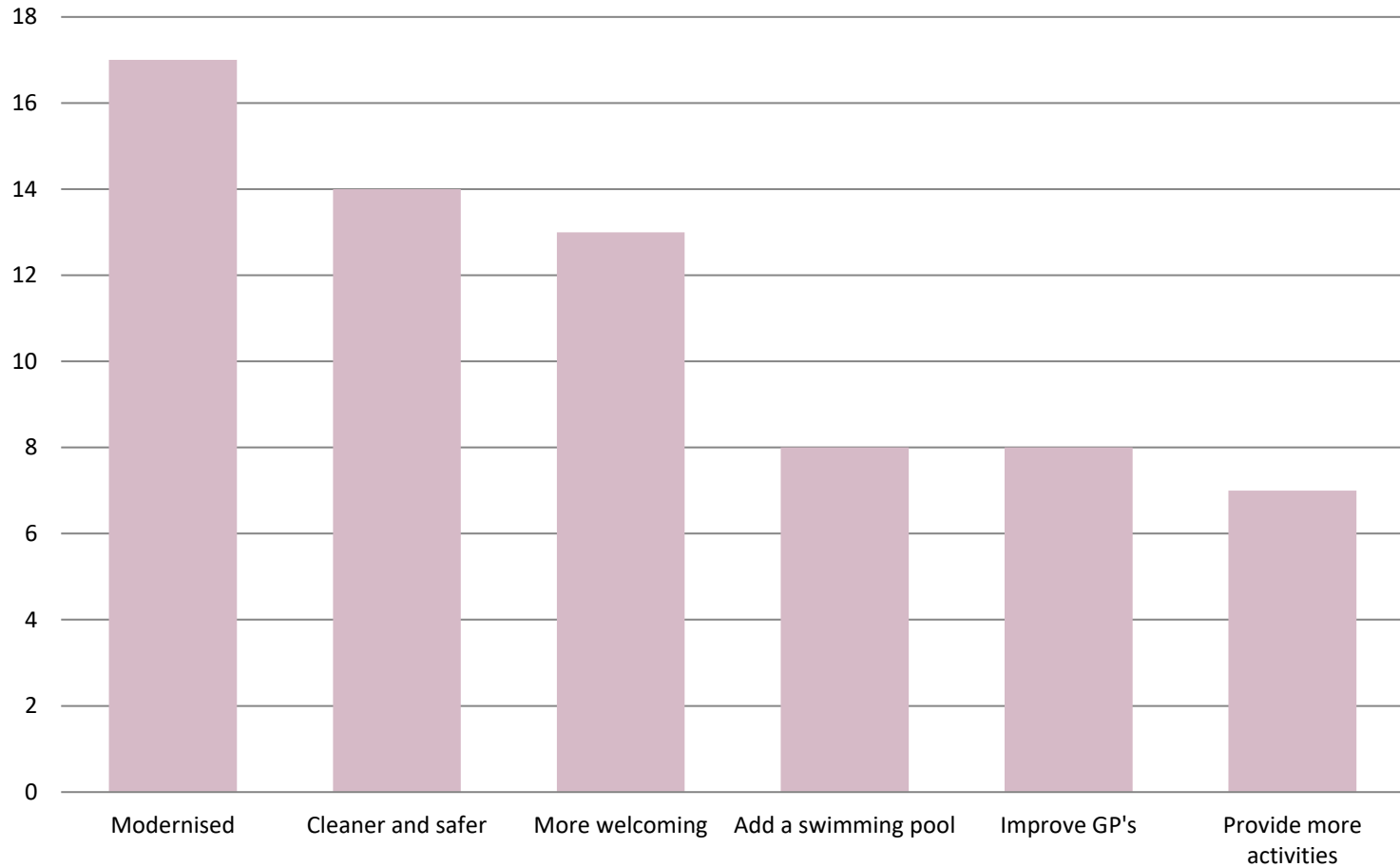
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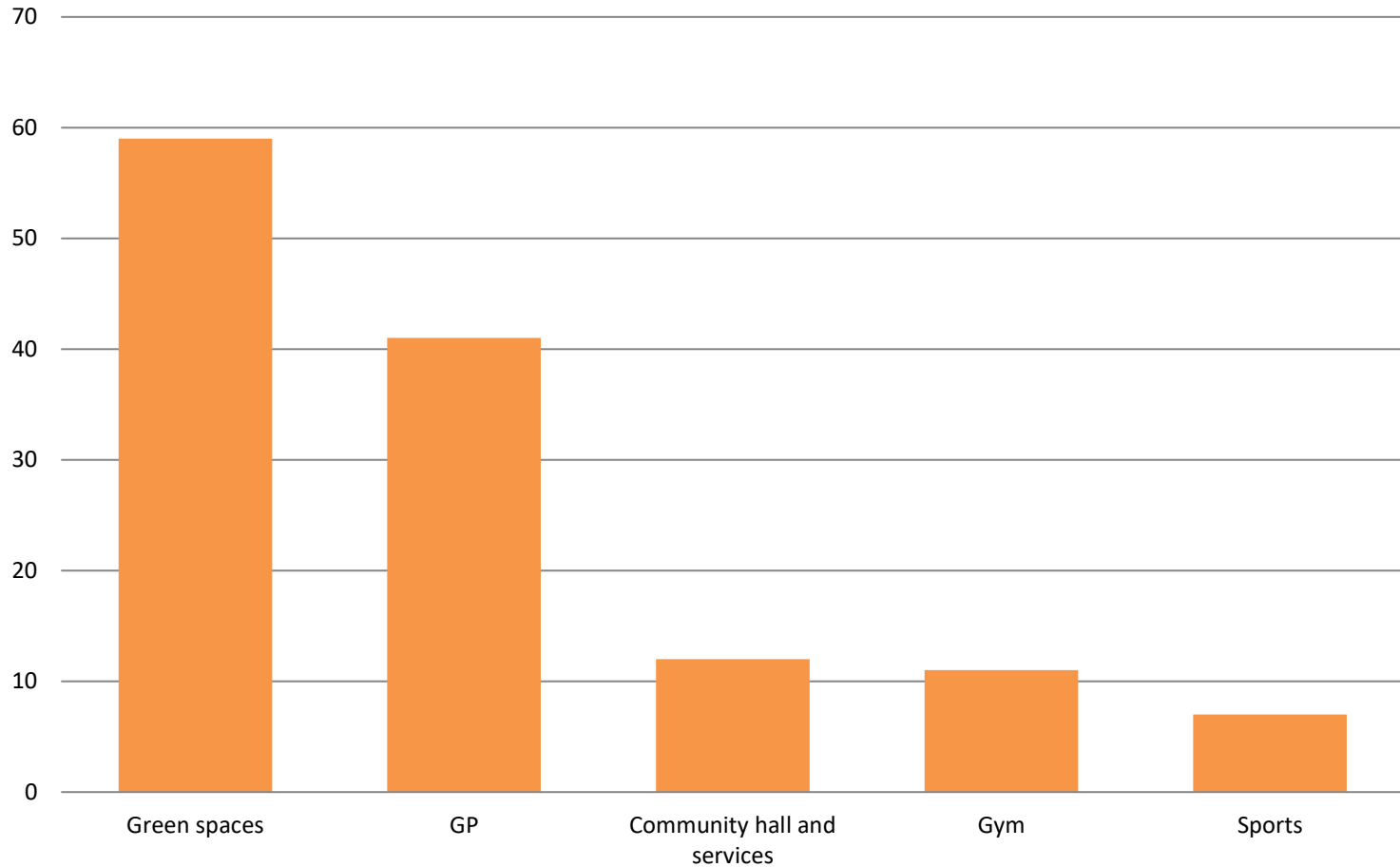
