Introduction


In July and August we conducted two online surveys to find out what local residents wanted to see in the new Wonford Health and Well-Being Hub. One was with the general public, and the other with pupils from two local secondary schools, Isca Academy and St Peter's.

- ➤ General survey: 341 households, 980 residents (80% Wonford residents)
- Schools survey: 80 responses
- Surveys for young people and people with disabilities is still ongoing.




Very excited at the prospect of a new community hub with modern ideas and some activities which have been lost over time. Like the lunch club and dances!


Total Wonford survey respondents (residents) by **age**and gender



Do you or anyone in your household have any **physical or emotional needs** that need to be met when you're out and about? (n=143)




What 7 **social activities and facilities** you or your household would like to use in the new HWB Hub? (n=310)






What 6 outdoor spaces, activities & facilities would you or your household like to use in the new HWB Hub and green spaces? (n=299)






What 10 things you'd like to have in a new Wonford Health and Well-Being Hub? (Young people n=72)






What 10 health & well-being support services would you or your household like to use at the new HWB Hub? (n=292)






What 10 **physical facilities & activities** would you or your household like to use at the new HWB Hub? (n=286)






The children of this area are desperate to have something to be a part of, to keep them off the streets and bring them together as a community.
